The changed shape of Aral Sea since 1960

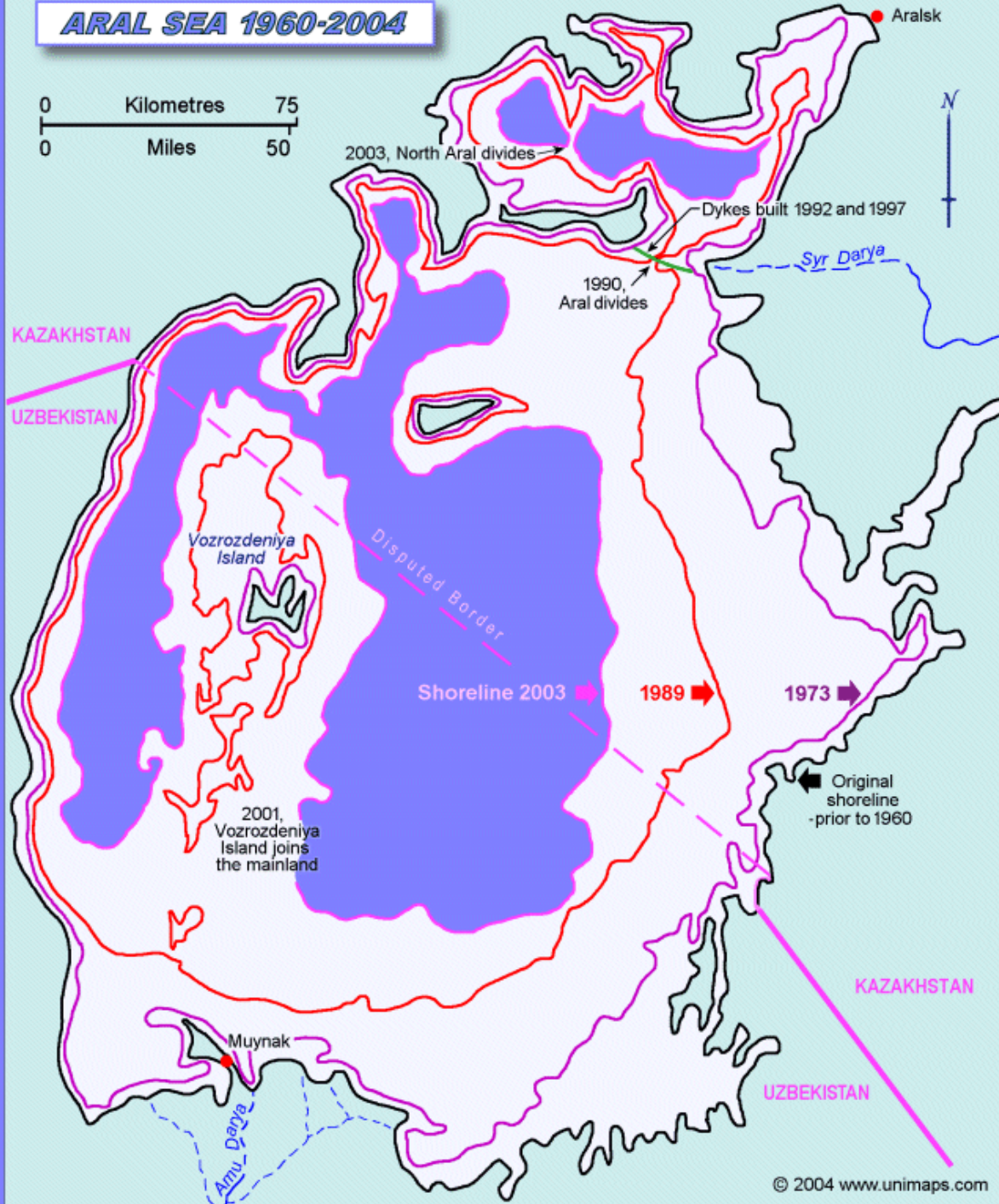

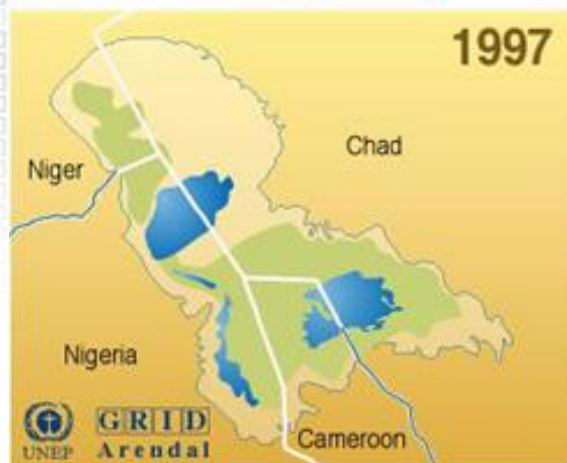








The Disappearance of Lake Chad in Africa
